A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING RESOLUTION 2026-069; DECLARING AN END TO THE BURN BAN; REQUIRING PUBLICATION OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, The Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners ("the Board") has enacted Ordinance 2018-016 ("the Ordinance") which provides the Board with authority to adopt a Resolution declaring drought emergencies, imposing appropriate restrictions to address rapidly changing drought conditions, and to repeal, amend or modify such Resolutions when conditions change; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief for Charlotte County has advised the potential for extreme fire behavior resulting from drought conditions in Charlotte County has since receded and recommends lifting the restrictions and prohibitions imposed by Resolution 2026-069; and

WHEREAS, having considered the recommendation of the Fire Chief, the Board has determined it is in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare to declare an end to the burn ban and to lift all restrictions and prohibitions on open burning and the discharge of fireworks or other incendiary devices in Charlotte County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Resolution 2026-069 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Board hereby lifts the ban on all outdoor burning (including yard waste, recreational fires, and pile burning for land clearing), the private use and discharge of fireworks and sparklers, and all other restrictions imposed under Resolution 2026-069.

Section 3. A summary of this Resolution shall be published twice, in a quarter page advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in Charlotte County, with the second advertisement appearing no more than five (5) days after publication of the first advertisement.

Section 4. This Resolution will become effective immediately upon passage by the Board.
