PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the eleventh annual "Imagine a Day Without Water" campaign is an organized effort to highlight the critical importance of access to clean water in our lives and the investment in infrastructure that is necessary to protect this valuable resource; and

WHEREAS, water infrastructure is the lifeline of our communities; a day without water would be a public health and safety crisis, limiting the abilities of safety personnel such as firefighters and hospital staff, as well as businesses and homes, to function; and

WHEREAS, our water infrastructure is necessary for a thriving economy, and a single nationwide day without water service would put our entire economy at risk; and

WHEREAS, different regions face different water challenges, so the solutions to strengthen our drinking water and wastewater systems must be locally driven, but reinvestment in our water must be a national priority.
