1 ORDINANCE 2 **NUMBER 2025-**3 4 OF THE AN ORDINANCE BOARD OF COUNTY 5 COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; 6 AMENDING SECTION 2-4-79 OF THE CODE OF LAWS 7 AND ORDINANCES OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, 8 TO PROHIBIT PARKING OF VEHICLES ON PORTIONS OF 9 THE RIGHT OF WAY OF WINDWARD ROAD AND 10 ARLINGTON DRIVE IN CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA: PROVIDING FOR **PENALTIES FOR** VIOLATION: 11 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: AND PROVIDING AN 12 13 EFFECTIVE DATE. 14 15 RECITALS 16 17 WHEREAS, Section 316.006 (3), Florida Statutes, provides that counties shall 18 have original jurisdiction of all streets and highways located within its boundaries, except 19 state and municipal roads, and may place and maintain such traffic control devices which 20 conform to the manual and specifications of the Department of Transportation upon all 21 streets and highways under their original jurisdiction as they deem necessary to regulate, 22 warn or guide traffic; and 23 WHEREAS, Section 316.1945, Florida Statutes, provides that a law enforcement 24 officer or parking enforcement specialist who discovers a vehicle parked in violation of 25 Section 316.1945 or a municipal or county ordinance may issue a ticket to the offending 26 driver or if the vehicle is unattended, attach the ticket to the vehicle in a conspicuous 27 place; and 28 WHEREAS, the County has received complaints from the public regarding the 29 parking of vehicles on the end "hammer head rights-of-way" of Windward Road and

Arlington Drive in Charlotte County, Florida; and

31	WHEREAS, the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department of Charlotte			
32	County has identified said rights-of-way as shown on Exhibits 1-2, attached hereto and			
33	made a part hereof, as an area where vehicles parked at the west end of Windward Road			
34	and Arlington Drive, right-of-way, at the hammer heads, will not allow the proper use of			
35	the hammer head for vehicles to turn around; and			
36	WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the			
37	residents of Charlotte County to prohibit parking at the locations described herein.			
38	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners			
39	of Charlotte County, Florida, that:			
40	Section 1. Section 2-4-79(b), Charlotte County Code, is hereby amended as			
41	follows (<u>underlined</u> sections are additions; strikethrough sections are deletions):			
42 43 44	Section 2-4-79(b) (b) <i>Prohibited.</i> It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle within the right-of-way of the following locations:			
45 46	(1) County Road 74 between U.S. 17/S.R. 35 and the Glades County line.			
47 48	(2) Taylor Road between Cooper Street and Airport Road.			
49 50	(3) Enterprise Drive between U.S. 41/S.R. 45 and S.R. 776.			
51 52	(4) Olean Boulevard between Aaron Street and Harbor Boulevard.			
53 54	(5) Harbor Boulevard between Aaron Street and Olean Boulevard.

57 58	(7) Florida Street between Bailey Street and Henry Street

130	Section 2. Violations of this Ordinance, and the penalties therefor, shall be as			
131	provided by general law.			
132	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application			
133	thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other			
134	provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid			
135	provision or applications. To this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared			
136	severable.			
137	Section 4. Effective Date. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the			
138	Department of State of the State of Florida within 10 days of enactment and shall take			
139	effect upon filing with said department.
