

**RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING RESOLUTION 2023-030; APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE REVISED AND AMENDED FEES FOR USE OF FACILITIES AND SERVICES UNDER THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR FUTURE AMENDMENT OF FEES; PROVIDING FOR REDUCTION OR WAIVER OF FEES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida (the "Board"), pursuant to Section 1-11-43, Charlotte County Code, finds it to be in the best interests of the County to charge fees to individuals and entities for use of County facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, the Board has previously adopted Resolution 2023-030 governing fees for the use of County facilities and services, under the supervision of the Charlotte County Community Services Department (the "Department"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida:

1. The Board hereby repeals Resolution 2023-030 and approves and adopts the revised and amended fee schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and the amended fee schedule for Port Charlotte Beach Recreation Center Rental Space, attached hereto as Exhibit "B."
2. The County Administrator, or his/her designee, shall develop procedures for collection of the fees outlined in Exhibits "A" and "B" and shall collect fees in accordance with such procedures and this Resolution.
3. Without further approval by the Board, the County Administrator, or his/her designee, has the authority to increase or decrease any fee contained in Exhibit "A" and "B" up to ten percent (10%) once per year. This authority must be applied uniformly rather than selectively. This authority does not extend to the creation of new fees not contained in Exhibit "A" and "B". The imposition of new fees shall require prior approval of the Board.

4. The County Administrator, or his/her designee, has the authority to waive or decrease fees to those who apply for assistance pursuant to the Community Services Co-Sponsorship Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and incorporated herein by reference. Request for assistance in excess of the established policy shall require approval of the Board.
5. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption by the Board.
