Water Quality Infrastructure Sales Tax (2020)

Budget \$7,000,000

FY21-22

- Sewer Force Main, Ackerman Ave.

FY25-26

- Sewer Force Main, Lakeview Blvd. to U.S. 41
- Sewer Force Main, Ellicott Cir. to W. Tarpon Blvd. NW

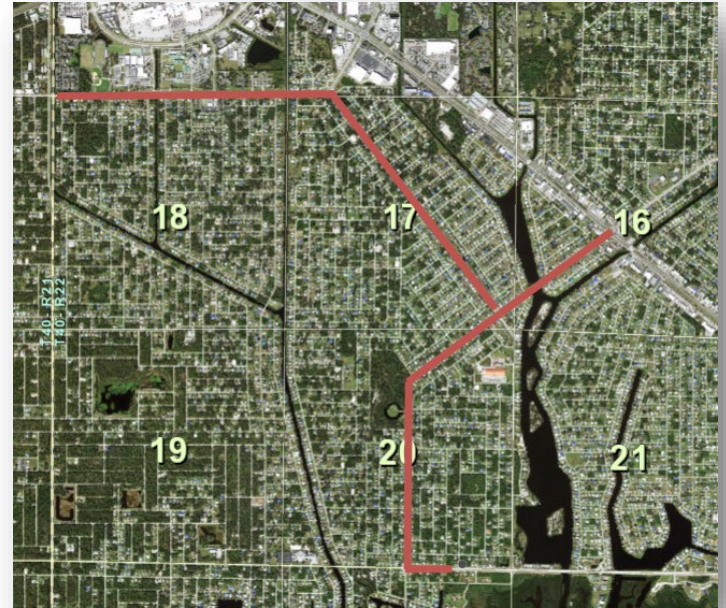
FY26-27

- Sewer Force Main: Cochran to Lakeview/Midway; Altoona to Wawa on U.S. 41
- Sewer Force Main: State Road 776
- Burnt Store WRF

Sales Tax (2020)

Sewer Force Main: Cochran from Collingswood to Lake View/Midway; and from Altoona lift station to Wawa on U.S. 41.

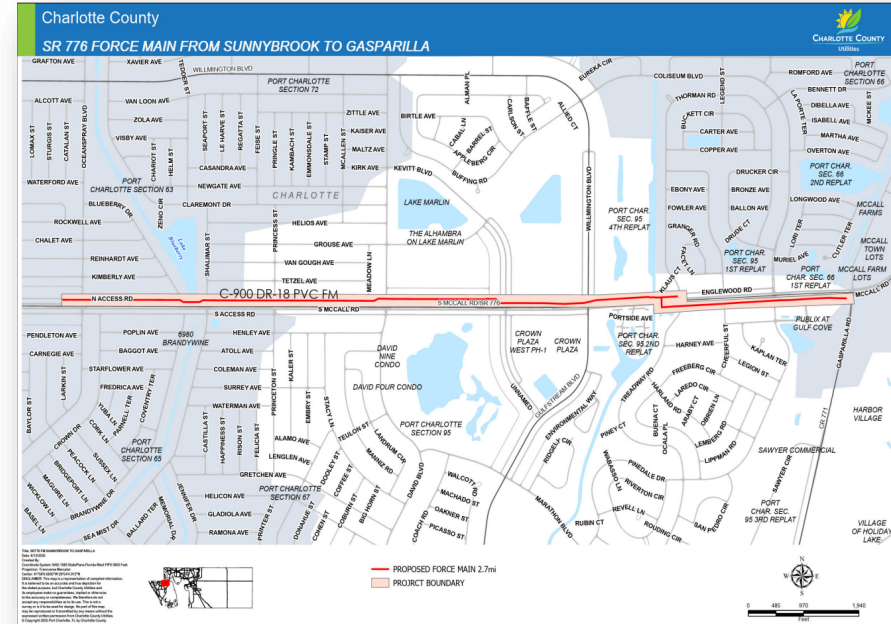
- Goal: Install a force main to allow for future septic to sewer connections.
- Sales tax allotment: \$1,000,000



Sales Tax (2020)

State Road 776 Force Main

- Goal: This project meets the area's service needs west of Gasparilla Road along SR776. A new force main will increase capacity and redirect flow away from Englewood Water District.
- Location: State Road 776 from Sunnybrook Boulevard to Gasparilla Road.
- Sales tax allotment: \$1,000,000



Sales Tax (2020)

Burnt Store WRF

- Goal: Meet the growing needs of the Burnt Store service area.
- Oct. 14, 2025: Board of County Commission approved temporary and permanent plants to increase capacity.
- Sales tax allotment: \$1,000,000
