

32 Section 2. Penalties for violations. Violations of this Ordinance, and the
33 penalties therefor, shall be as provided by general law.

34 Section 3. Name or road designation changes. The speed limits set upon the
35 road sections described in this Ordinance shall not be affected by name or road
36 designation changes.

37 Section 4. Conflict with other ordinances. The provisions of this Ordinance
38 shall control to the extent of any conflict with any other county ordinance.

39 Section 5. Incorporation of Exhibits. The attached exhibits are hereby
40 incorporated herein and made a part of this Ordinance.

41 Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application
42 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other
43 provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid
44 provision or applications. To this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared
45 severable.

46 Section 7. Effective Date. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed
47 with the Department of State of the State of Florida within 10 days of enactment and shall
48 take effect upon filing with said department.

EXISTING SPEED LIMIT

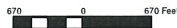
