PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, correctional officers have the difficult and often dangerous assignment of ensuring the custody, safety and well-being of inmates in our counties jails and state prisons; and

WHEREAS, the duties of these officers have become increasingly complex and demanding, as they are called upon to simultaneously fill custodial, supervisory, and counseling roles; and

WHEREAS, the professionalism, dedication, and courage exhibited by these officers throughout the performance of these demanding and often conflicting roles deserve our utmost respect; and

WHEREAS, by a joint resolution approved May 5, 1984, Congress requested Ronald Reagan, as the President of the United States, to designate the week beginning May 6, 1984, as "National Correctional Officers Week"; and

WHEREAS, each year we recognize and honor the many contributions and accomplishments of these men and women who are a vital component of the field of corrections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the week of May 3rd – 9th shall be known in all of Charlotte County as
