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A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY; PROVIDING STANDARD APPLICATION PACKET ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida (the "Board"), has adopted an Ordinance authorizing the Department of Public Safety to accept and issue Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("COPCN") for transportation of basic and advanced life support patients; and

WHEREAS, these services are independent of the existing duties of the Department; and

WHEREAS, there is a desire to perform the services and recoup the costs incurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida, that:

1. The fees to be charged for services provided by the Department, in response to COPCN requests, are hereby established in accordance with the fee schedule set out below:

A. New Application	\$1000.00
B. Renewal Application	\$500.00
C. Registration (per vehicle)	\$50.00

2. Any Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed, but only to the extent of the conflict and as required in order to give this Resolution full force and effect. In the event any provision of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such provision shall be considered severed and, to the greatest extent practicable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.


