Failure to meet delivery or lead time necessitating Charlotte County to make purchase(s) from other sources shall cause successful Contractor to be held liable for the difference of cost between awarded quote price and the cost of the required purchase from another source.

Bulk deliveries shall be delivered to all locations every week.

If notified of the acceptance of this bid form, the undersigned agrees to execute a Contract for the stated compensation in the form as prescribed by the County, within the time constraints outlined in Instructions to Bidders.
