A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH CENTRAL FLORIDA BEHAVIORAL HEALTH NETWORK, INC. FOR CORE OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDING (PURCHASE AGREEMENT #PL318).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Charlotte County has suffered harm as a result of the opioid epidemic;  
and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida adopted Resolution 2021-077 agreeing to participate in the Florida Unified Plan governing the allocation and use of opioid settlement proceeds; and

WHEREAS, opioid settlement funds allocated to Charlotte County are administered through the Florida Department of Children and Families and managed regionally by Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Charlotte County Fire & EMS seeks to access Fiscal Year 2025–2026 CORE opioid settlement funding for an eligible program consistent with the Florida Unified Plan; and

WHEREAS, Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc. and Charlotte County have negotiated Purchase Agreement #PL318 to allow the County to access such funding;  
and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it in the best interest of the County to approve the Purchase Agreement and authorize administrative execution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of

Charlotte County, Florida that:

1. The County Administrator, or one of his or her designees, is hereby authorized to execute Purchase Agreement #PL318 with Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc., together with any related, non-substantive documents required to implement the Agreement, provided such documents are consistent with the Florida Unified Plan and this Resolution.
