

## ECONOMIC IMPACT ESTIMATE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING CHAPTER 4-6, ARTICLE X, ESTABLISHING DIVISION II – ADVISORY BOARD; AMENDING SECTION 4-6-195 OF THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE COOK AND BROWN STREET UNIT ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners find it in the best interest of the public to establish an MSBU advisory board for the Cook and Brown Street Unit. Pursuant to its Home Rule Charter, advisory boards must be created via ordinance.
