NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the Consultant agree to amend the Contract as follows:

ARTICLE 1. COMPENSATION / SERVICES

- 1.1. The following provisions of this Amendment, together with Exhibit A (Scope of Services / Fee), attached hereto and incorporated herein, are specifically incorporated into and made a part of the Contract.
- 1.2. The Scope of Services for the Project is hereby amended to add Task 16 (FEMA Arbitration Support and Coordination), as described in Exhibit A to this Amendment.

- 1.5. Payment for services rendered on Task 16 shall be made monthly based on the number of hours spent and the hourly rates specified in Exhibit A. Billings shall be detailed as to the nature of the tasks performed, the associate performing the task,

the number of hours spent on each task, and the applicable hourly rate(s).

- 2.1. The effective date of this Amendment #2 is the date on which it is signed by both parties.
- 2.2. Any terms used in this Amendment #2 shall have the same meanings and definitions as they have in the Contract.
- 2.3. All other provisions of the Contract not in conflict with this Amendment #2 shall remain in full force and effect.
