

**EyeMed Vision Care, LLC – Charlotte County Government
Second Amendment to Fee for Service Agreement**

This Second Amendment to the Fee for Service Agreement ("Second Amendment") is effective October 1, 2023, and is entered into by and between EyeMed Vision Care, LLC ("EyeMed") and First American Administrators, Inc. ("FAA"), with their principal place of business at 4000 Luxottica Place, Mason, OH 45040 and Charlotte County Government with its principal place of business at 18500 Murdock Circle, Suite 536, Port Charlotte, FL 33948 as Employer and Plan Administrator ("Employer"), collectively known as (the "Parties").

WHEREAS, effective October 1, 2016, the Parties entered into a Fee for Service Agreement;

WHEREAS, effective October 1, 2022, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Fee for Service Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section XIII, Subsection M of the Fee for Service Agreement the Parties reserve the right to modify the Fee for Service Agreement in a writing signed by both Parties; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now agree to amend the Fee for Service Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, it is agreed as follows:

- I. The Agreement shall renew effective October 1, 2023 for twelve (12) months.
- II. The Parties agree that in all other respects the Fee for Service Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
- III. This Second Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Any capitalized words not defined in this Second Amendment shall have the same meaning as given in the Fee for Service Agreement.
