OF THE CODE OF LAWS 7 AND ORDINANCES OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; 8 AMENDING THE SPEED LIMITS ON DON PEDRO ISLAND 9 IN CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR 10 PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING THAT THE 11 SPEED LIMIT IS NOT AFFECTED BY NAME OR ROAD 12 DESIGNATION CHANGE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT **ORDINANCES:** 13 WITH OTHER PROVIDING **FOR** 14 INCORPORATION OF EXHIBITS: **PROVIDING FOR** SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE 15 16 DATE. 17 **RECITALS** 18 19 WHEREAS, Section 316.189, Florida Statutes, designates speed limits on county-20 maintained roads, unless otherwise set by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant 21 to an investigation and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the State Department of 22 Transportation; and 23 WHEREAS, an investigation performed by the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department of Charlotte County of the speed limit on Don Pedro Island as depicted 24 25 on Exhibit 1 indicates that establishment of the following speed limits on the below 26 designated roads are reasonable. 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida, that: 28 29 Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 316.189, Florida 30 Statutes, the speed limit shall change from 25 miles per hour to 20 miles per hour on N. Gulf Boulevard and from 25 miles per hour to 15 miles per hour on unpaved roads/ferry 31

34	Section 2. Penalties for violations. Violations of this Ordinance, and the		
35	penalties therefor, shall be as provided by general law.		
36	Section 3. Name or road designation changes. The speed limits set upon the		
37	road sections described in this Ordinance shall not be affected by name or road		
38	designation changes.		
39	Section 4. Conflict with other ordinances. The provisions of this Ordinance		
40	shall control to the extent of any conflict with any other county ordinance.		
41	Section 5. Incorporation of Exhibits. The attached exhibits are hereby		
42	incorporated herein and made a part of this Ordinance.		
43	Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application		
44	thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other		
45	provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid		
46	provision or applications. To this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared		
47	severable.		
48	Section 7. Effective Date. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed		
49	with the Department of State of the State of Florida within 10 days of enactment and shall		
50	take effect upon filing with said department.
