F. *Estimate of County's regulatory costs, including any new revenue from fees/charges:*

To be determined via the system's placement and scheduled usage. Each violation carries a standard fee of \$100 and is remitted per HB 657 requirements. Those requirements are: \$20 to the Department of Revenue's General Revenue Fund; \$60 to be retained by the County for system administration and other public safety initiatives (our vendor system usage fee of \$21 is drawn from this area); \$12 to the school district for school safety initiatives; \$5 for the County's School Crossing Guard Recruitment and Retention program; \$3 to the Department of Revenue's Law Enforcement Criminal Justice Standards and Training Trust fund.

No business is directly impacted by the Ordinance adoption. However, a business may be impacted by this Ordinance if a motor vehicle registered to the business commits a school zone speed infraction.

Florida CS/CS/HB 657: Enforcement of School Zone Speed Limits sets the required violation fee and its funding breakdown.

The County Tax Collector has a computer program, which takes data from the tax rolls and identifies all existing businesses/categorizes them by specific type.
