HEREAS, the observance of this day serves to educate the public on the laws granting the right-of-way to individuals using a white cane or other mobility aids; and

HEREAS, the white cane promotes safety, confidence, and independence for people with vision loss, supporting their inclusion in all aspects of life; and

HEREAS, Charlotte County empowers individuals who are blind or visually impaired by promoting accessibility, independence, and community support; and

HEREAS, recognizing National White Cane Day affirms the community's commitment to inclusion, equal opportunity, and the celebration of diversity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the 15th of October 2025 shall be known in all of Charlotte County as

National White Cane Day
