WHEREAS, September 17, 2025, marks the two hundred and thirty fourth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the signing of the Constitution and of Americans who strive to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of citizenship, The Congress, Public Law #915; and

WHEREAS, signed by President Dwight D. Eisenhower on August 2, 1956, designated the week beginning September 17th and ending September 23rd of each year as "Constitution Week".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that September 17, 2025, shall be known in all of Charlotte County as

Constitution Week

And the Daughters of the American Revolution ask our citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the Frames of the Constitution had in the 1787 by vigilant protecting the freedoms of Americans
