

Food and Water:

- ☐ Food (Enough for at least seven (7) days, nonperishable packaged or canned food and beverages, snack foods, juices, baby food, and any special dietary items)
- Non-electric can opener
- Paper plates and napkins Plastic cups and utensils
- □ Water (1 gallon per person per day)

Clothing:

☐ Include seasonal or rain gear and sturdy shoes or boots.

☐ Keep your motor vehicle tanks filled with gas

Maintain a list of important phone numbers including:
