PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in November 1918, the first World war; the war to end all wars, officially ended; and

WHEREAS, November 11 marked the cessation of the most destructive and far reaching war in human events and the resumption by the people of the United States of peaceful relations with other nations; and

WHEREAS, in November 1919, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day; and

WHEREAS, the original concept for the celebration was for a day to honor our veterans, a day observed with parades, public meetings, a brief suspension of business, patriotic events; and

WHEREAS, President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed legislation on June 1, 1954 to make the change from Armistice Day to Veterans Day; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that the recurring anniversary of this date should be commemorated with thanksgiving and prayer and exercises designed to honor our veterans and to perpetuate peace through good will and mutual understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that November 11, 2025, shall be known in all of Charlotte County as

Veterans Day
