PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, from the beginning of this Nation, law enforcement officers have played an important role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms which are guaranteed by the Constitution and in protecting the lives and property of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, through constant application of new procedures and techniques, such officers are becoming more efficient in the execution of their duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, it is important that our people understand the problems, duties and responsibilities of their law enforcement agencies and the necessity for partnering with them in maintaining law and order; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that we express our gratitude for the dedicated service and courageous deeds of law enforcement officers and for contributions they make to the security and well-being of all our people; and

WHEREAS, by a joint resolution approved October 1st 1962, Congress has requested the President of the United States to designate May 15th of each year as "Peace Officers Memorial Day" and the calendar week such May 15th occurs as "Police Week."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the week of May 15th, 2025 shall be known in all of Charlotte County as

National Police Week
