

**WATER QUALITY PROTECTION, FISH AND WILDLIFE HABITAT PRESERVATION,
AND PARKS AD VALOREM TAX AND BONDS(15 words/15 allowed)**

To finance the acquisition, improvement, and management of environmentally sensitive lands to protect drinking water sources and water quality, preserve fish and wildlife habitat, reduce flooding, and provide parks, shall Charlotte County levy an additional 0.20 mill ad valorem tax and issue general obligation bonds in a total principal amount not exceeding \$70,000, 000 maturing within 20 years, bearing interest not exceeding the legal rate, payable from such ad valorem taxes, with annual public audits? (75 words/75 allowed)
