


Statewide Keetch-Byram Drought Index (KBDI) February 24, 2025 – Charlotte County 586










Seasonal Outlook

Issued January 16th, 2025








County Enacted Bans

Forecast/Outlook Impacts

Increased potential for wildland and/or urban interface fires Dry and windy conditions mean

- Fires start with little effort
- · Burn with greater intensity
- Spread quickly
- Post hurricane fuel load
- Demand on emergency resources

Risk to health and property

- Charlotte Special Needs Registry 496
- Wildfires can pose significant health risk for those with respiratory issues.
- Wildfires rank #2 of all combined weather-related threats (FDOH)
- Increased growths leads to greater potential for wildland-urban interface fires
- 2021 Wildfire damages \$70-\$90 billion nationwide (Accuweather)
