PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Rotonda West Association, a deed-restricted community found in the beautiful Cape Haze area of Charlotte County is dedicating the Statue of Liberty located on Liberty Island at 108 Boundary Boulevard, Rotonda West, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the 8-foot-tall Statue of Liberty was donated by residents Todd Talley and Phyllis Stewart of Rotonda West who transported it from Eureka Springs, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the Statue of Liberty had stood in the front courtyard of the Crescent Hotel in Eureka Springs for well over 100 years before being acquired by Todd and Phyllis; and

WHEREAS, the Rotonda West Association landscaped Liberty Island which was previously known as Gazebo Island and built a pedestal to display the statue; and

WHEREAS, the Statue of Liberty and Liberty Island will benefit all the residents of Rotonda West for many years to come and is especially significant during the 250th year of the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the 23rd day of May 2026 shall be designated and observed in Charlotte County as
