Dear Mr. Fruecht,

Poole & Kent prepared a cost estimate to construct the changes to the concrete on the effluent boxes on Clarifier #3 & #4 with the installation of additional piping and fitting to accommodate the location of the existing 30" effluent piping. This direction was provided to P&K in RFI #93A response, have not received the formal PCM. We propose to incorporate the work, as clarified herein, for a lump sum increase to our contract in the amount of \$87,688.71 and (0) calendar days to the contract completion date.

This proposal includes the following clarifications.

1. This proposal is valid for a period of 21 days, after which it is void at the option of Poole & Kent.
2. Pricing is based on normal working hours and does not include any overtime.

In regards to the 30" effluent lines at Clarifiers 3 & 4, PK potholed to expose both "connection" points. Neither are what is indicated on the drawings. Clarifier #3, the tee is orientated differently from what is shown. Clarifier #4, there is no tie in point, we exposed just pipe, no tee or fittings to connect to. Please see the attached drawing for reference. This is an active line with no way to isolate. For Clarifier #4, advise on how to tie into this line. For Clarifier #3, please advise on how to revise the piping to make the existing connection work or supply us on degrees and angles to rotate the clarifier effluent box to make the connection work.

- Lastly, there also is no 42" x 30" reducer on this line where shown. Potentially 3 or 4 30" effluent lines off the clarifiers will be tying into the same 30" common pipe. Please confirm this is acceptable with flow calculations.
