A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN CHARLOTTE COUNTY AND THE CENTER FOR ABUSE AND RAPE EMERGENCIES OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, INC., LEASING REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE MID-COUNTY MINI-TRANSFER & RECYCLING FACILITY, LOCATED AT 19765 KENILWORTH BOULEVARD, PORT CHARLOTTE, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS/HER DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS, EXTENSIONS, TERMINATIONS, AND NOVATION CHANGES TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

RECITALS

WHEREAS, section 125.38, Florida Statutes, permits counties to lease county-owned property to not-for-profit organizations which are organized for the purpose of promoting public or community interest and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Abuse and Rape Emergencies of Charlotte County, Inc. ("C.A.R.E."), a Florida not-for-profit corporation, has applied to lease the Mid-County Mini-Transfer & Recycling Facility located at 19765 Kenilworth Boulevard, Port Charlotte, Florida 33954; and

WHEREAS, Charlotte County, in accordance with the provisions of section 125.38, Florida Statutes, finds that the above-referenced property is not currently required for county use and would best serve the interest and welfare of the community by being used by the organization named herein; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida desires to lease said property to C.A.R.E.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County, Florida that:

1. The Board hereby finds that C.A.R.E., a non-profit corporation of the State of Florida, has applied to lease County-owned property located at 19765 Kenilworth Boulevard, Port Charlotte, Florida 33954, for the purpose of serving the citizens of Charlotte County through advocating on behalf of victims and survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and other crimes.

2. Having found the following organization to be the best suited to implement the desired public services, the Board hereby approves a Lease Agreement with C.A.R.E. for an initial term of three (3) years retroactively from May 1, 2026 through September 30, 2029, with an option to renew for two (2) separate additional terms of one (1) year with C.A.R.E. paying an annual rate of One Dollar (\$1).

3. The Board hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Lease Agreement on behalf of the County.

4. The Board hereby authorizes the County Administrator, or his designee, to execute amendments, extensions, terminations, and novation changes to the Lease Agreement as necessary on behalf of the County.

5. The Resolution shall take effect upon adoption
