TODD R. REBOL, PE

Mr. Rebol, as a Vice President and Principal of *Banks Engineering*, is responsible for the management of the Port Charlotte branch office which services Charlotte County, DeSoto County and the City of North Port. As manager, he is responsible for the everyday operations of the office, which includes the management of projects and personnel. He utilizes this to place individuals on a project that will draw upon the individual's best engineering and/or surveying

skills for that particular project. In addition to his experience as a manager for Banks Engineering, he has comprehensive experience in the design, permitting, management and construction of a large range of projects for both the public and private sectors.

REFERENCE PROJECTS

Sidewalks - Year Three Improvements (Charlotte County, Florida) — This project includes approximately 20 miles of sidewalk improvements throughout Charlotte County. **Banks Engineering** was responsible for the surveying, design, permitting and limited construction services for the three sidewalk segments (Sandhill Boulevard, Rio de Janeiro Boulevard and Deep Creek Boulevard) located within the Deep Creek Community. The total length of proposed sidewalks that **Banks Engineering** was responsible for in this project is approximately 4.9 miles.

Edgewater Boulevard Improvements (Charlotte County, Florida) - This project is an approximate 2.5 mile widening of an existing two lane roadway to a four lane roadway. Banks Engineering's design responsibilities included replacement of existing water main with a 16" water main, replacement of existing force main with a 10" and 12" force main, design of new 12" reuse main including services and design of gravity system to be incorporated into the roadway in order to collect existing homes on the roadway corridor and pocket neighborhoods directly adjacent to the roadway. We also provided survey support services for the entire project limits.

Bermont Road Improvements (Charlotte County, Florida) — This project includes approximately the addition of paved shoulders and specific drainage improvements to approximately 15 miles of Bermont Road in Charlotte County. Banks Engineering's survey responsibilities for the project include the establishment of control and a route survey for approximately eight (8) miles of the proposed project. The surveys included the field work necessary to complete the design services including slopes of existing swales and topographic data for adjacent properties to determine existing drainage patterns.

Harbor Boulevard Improvements (Charlotte County, Florida) - This project is an approximate 0.5 mile of improvements to an existing four lane roadway. **Banks Engineering's** surveying responsibilities include the establishment of horizontal and vertical control, establishment of existing right-of-ways, topographic survey, location of underground utilities, and descriptions of parcels for easements and takings.
