Proposed Changes

- To amend Section 3-9-2. Rules of Construction, Definitions by adding the new definition of Farmers' Market, and revising the existing definition of "Park" and "Private Park".
- To create new Section 3-9-91 Accessory Use -Farmers' Market.
- County-wide.



Major Detailed Changes

New Definition of Farmers' Market: a location where, as an accessory use subject to Section 3-9-91. Accessory Use - Farmers' Market, as may be amended, agricultural and organic items, arts and crafts, or other similar goods, may be offered for sale. Resale of retail items is not permitted.



Major Detailed Changes

Park, <u>public</u>: A tract of land <u>owned by a governmental entity that is</u> used by the public for active and passive recreation, <u>and related</u> <u>events</u>. <u>Public park uses shall be subject to rules and regulations</u> <u>promulgated by the government entity which owns the public park</u>.

Private pPark, not-for profit: A park facility operated by a nonprofit organization (such as a homeowners or condominium association) which is open only to bona fide members and guests invitees of said organization the not-for-profit park's owner. Commercially operated parks are not within included in this definition.
