20	WHEREAS, Section 316.189, Florida Statutes, designates speed limits on county-		
21	maintained roads, unless otherwise set by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant		
22	to an investigation and in conformity with criteria promulgated by the State Department o		
23	Transportation; and		
24	WHEREAS, an investigation performed by the Engineering Division of the Public		
25	Works Department of Charlotte County of the speed limit on a portion of Carmalita Street		
26	as depicted on Exhibit 1 indicates that establishment of the following speed limits on the		
27	below designated roads is reasonable.		
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners		
29	of Charlotte County, Florida, that:		
30	Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 316.189, Florida Statutes,		
31	the speed limit shall change from 45 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour on Carmalita		
32	Street, 650 feet east of Education Avenue to Florida Street, as depicted on the attached		
33	Exhibit 2		

34	Section 2. Penalties for violations. Violations of this Ordinance, and the penalties
35	therefor, shall be as provided by general law.
36	Section 3. Name or road designation changes. The speed limits set upon the road
37	sections described in this Ordinance shall not be affected by name or road designation
38	changes.
39	Section 4. Conflict with other ordinances. The provisions of this Ordinance shall
40	control to the extent of any conflict with any other county ordinance.
11	Section 5. Incorporation of Exhibits. The attached exhibits are hereby incorporated
12	herein and made a part of this Ordinance.
43	Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof
14	to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions
45	or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision
46	or applications. To this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.
