PUBLIC PURPOSE:

This ordinance aims to reduce the speed limit on a portion of Carmalita St from 45MPH to 35MPH. The section is 650 feet east of Education Ave to Florida St. The development of Waterford Estates has built out along this portion of Carmalita St and Public Works has received numerous requests for a lower speed limit. Also, there are the active parks on the eastern end which has a lot of pedestrian traffic cross Carmalita. This will help add to the safety of the pedestrians and motorists.
