PROPOSED REVISION (Please include text in track changes mode or clearly indicate original text and proposed substitution)	The Task Force recognizes that the vision of M-CORES established by the Governor and Legislature in s. 338.278, F.S. is ambitious and its implementation will require continued strong coordination among state agencies, local governments, MPOs, RPCs, water management districts, and other agencies. The Task Force also recognizes that the economic and fiscal outlook facing Florida has changed significantly since the legislation authorizing the M-CORES program was signed in May 2019. Given the potential transformational impact of the M-CORES program on the future of Florida, the Task Force respectfully requests the Governor and Legislature to consider adjusting the deadlines for corridor construction and other milestones in statute to permit thorough analysis and thoughtful collaboration on all key decisions.
